



Although the office is located in the rural district where the unspoilt landscape is still maintained, the office is fully equipped with the same digital infrastructure as the main office in Tokyo, leaving no stress to the employees.


While the office is built inside the cowshed, the 100 year old, beautifully aged structure is left untouched. The steel structure sits detached from the cowshed, although in the case of major disaster, it functions as a key, preventing the 100 year old structure from collapsing.

We let it be by inhabiting it. We leave it untouched but we sustain it. We watch it keep aging.




PLAN 1:100




TRANSVERSE SECTION 1:100
