Historical pre-existences and architecture

X Edition - Call for Applications 2024-2025 "Projects developed as thesis" section

On March 26th, 2025, in the prestigious setting of Palazzo Tassoni Estense, home to the Department of Architecture at the University of Ferrara, the award ceremony for the 10th edition of the International Award Domus Restoration and Preservation Fassa Bortolo will take place. This year, the prize is enriched with the specification "Historical pre-existences and architecture."

The award, conceived and promoted by Fassa S.r.l., owner of the "Fassa Bortolo" brand, and the Department of Architecture at the University of Ferrara, aims to showcase architectural works that have embraced conservation as a cultural necessity and have been able to enhance historical preexistences while respecting their authenticity as layered palimpsests through a conscious design culture.

This year's competition category focuses on "projects developed as theses," with over 55 candidates from various Italian and international universities. The expert jury, composed of Chairman Prof. Marco Mulazzani, Secretary Prof. Marcello Balzani, and members Prof. Andrea Ugolini, Prof. Emanuelle Fidone, and Arch. Imma Jansana, carefully analyzed all submissions and selected the winners.

The jury decided to award two gold medals ex aequo and three silver medals ex aequo. Additionally, seven honourable mentions were granted for special merits and attention to detail, and seven more theses completed the shortlist.

Finally, regarding the Special Prize – Digital Technologies BIM, awarded to those who successfully integrated digital technologies and processes into their thesis work as tools for knowledge, documentation, management, and enhancement of the architectural asset undergoing conservation and restoration—beyond mere 3D modeling—one winning thesis was highlighted, along with two honourable mentions.

As usual, the award ceremony will be part of the program of the *Giornate del Restauro e del Patrimonio Culturale*, now in its seventh edition. This event is organized by the Department of Architecture of the University of Ferrara and will take place in Ferrara on March 26 and 27, 2025.
